## State Fire Marshal's Office Rescinds Most COVID-19 Temporary Agency Operations

**BATON ROUGE-** Following the latest public health emergency proclamation by Gov. John Bel Edwards, effective April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021, the Louisiana Office of State Fire Marshal (SFM) is informing the public about its return to conducting "business as usual," with a few exceptions.

- All SFM offices, including Headquarters in Baton Rouge, continue offering limited walk-in services to the public. Electronic communications for Plan Review, Inspections and Licensing, that ordinarily occur through the SFM's Information Management System (IMS), should continue and are encouraged.
- Non-critical annual, maintenance and licensing fire safety inspections, especially in healthcare facilities, are being scheduled once again. However, the following stipulations allow for continued postponement of these visits:
  - Active, Covid-positive individuals are present in a healthcare facility.
    - Please contact Lt. Bernadette Richard to discuss the option of a healthcare inspection still occurring in these circumstances. She can be reached at 225-454-9201 or Bernadette.richard@la.gov.
  - Corporate policy still not allowing non-resident and non-employee entry.
- Training classes have returned virtually with some classes beginning to be scheduled for inperson instruction. Visit lasfm.org for frequent, new additions to the training calendar.
